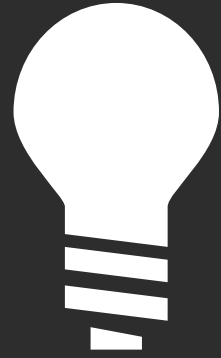

CPCS A62 Crane Supervisor Training

Course overview

This training course for the CPCS A62 crane supervisor role in the construction industry is carried out over 4 days with CPCS technical theoretical & practical test on the 4th day. The course is a mix of theory and practical training. It is advised that all delegates are prepared to do out of hours studying as trainers may give delegates exercises to complete before the next day's training to ensure any weaknesses are identified so the learning outcomes are achieved. Following successful completion of the course candidates will be able understand safe systems of work for lifting operations including compliance with legislation, regulations, codes of practice and operational requirements as set out by the appointed person.

Course structure

The course is a mix of theory and practical training. Delegates are evaluated by means of an assessment throughout the duration of the course which leads to a CPCS A62 theoretical & practical technical test, the delegate must pass the theoretical test to enable them to carry out the practical test.

Please note: The CPCS technical (theory) test questions are available to review prior to attending the course and can be downloaded online at NOCN job cards revision documents crane supervisor A62.

Q & A

What practical exercises will I be asked to complete?

Checking a mobile crane is set up by the operator as per manufactures recommendations, demonstrating the checking of crane certification, preparing toolbox talks and briefing the lifting team, setting up and checking exclusion zones, supervising and monitoring a lifting operation from start to finish.

What qualification will I gain from this course?

CPCS red card trained operator for A62 on passing the technical theoretical & practical test. The red CPCS card is only valid for 2 years. Within this period all delegates must complete an NVQ level 4 diploma to convert from red card to blue card. The blue CPCS card is valid for 5 years.

What is the course duration?

3 Days training & 1 day's CPCS theoretical & practical technical test.

Will I have to take an assessment?

Delegates are evaluated by means of an assessment throughout the duration of the CPCS A62 course by the instructors to help identify if there are any areas the delegate may need assistance in to ensure the learning outcomes are achieved before taking the CPCS theoretical & practical technical A62 test.

Who is most suited to attend this training?

Personnel wishing to gain training and CPCS qualification to work in the construction industry as crane supervisor.

What are the course pre-requisites?

Supervisors (SUP) H&S touch screen test pass within 2 years of test.
